Eight participated in a DI Leadership Seminar we held in Los Banos and the fruits are still growing. Several home Bible studies came out of this. I was blessed to visit People Need The Lord Children Ministry which grew to over 65 kids in less than 2 years, fruits of ETS students from Trinity. Forty-one Home Bible study leaders from six different churches are now studying the materials we shared with a local Pastor in Los Banos. An Education Centre was started for use for Bible studies, to help teach academic courses plus used by 11 teenagers for Music Workshops. All for children and adults living by the train rail tracks of Anos, Los Banos, Laguna.

This coming November 25th to December 17th, 2011, I am coordinating and leading Discipleship International Mission trip to Palawan and Los Banos in the Philippines. I will be staying in the Philippines until January 25th, 2012. What will we be doing in the Philippines?

With the help of the Holy Spirit and working together with local Pastors, we will be helping to equip Pastors, Lay leaders and Discipleship students by holding Leadership Seminars and Testimony Workshops. We will also be visiting Children Ministries. Door to door evangelism will be part of our outreach ministry. We are bringing 10 boxes of clothings, shoes, school supplies and Bibles to share with the locals. During my extended stay, I will be helping to complete the ETS training of a couple I disciplined last year and holding Discipleship Seminars in several churches and encouraging current ETS Leaders and students in Manila.

- **In leading and coordinating the Mission to Philippines Nov. 25th to Dec. 17th and my extended stay till Jan. 25th to continue training the couple I helped disciple**
- **To visit the Deaf Ministry International in Davao and assist in disciple making using ETS in January 10th to 13th**
- **To hold the Leader's ETS seminar in Manila on Jan. 14th and 15th 2012 at Manila Chinese Baptist Church**
- To be able to become full time in the ministry of disciple making at Discipleship International
- For expansion of Sandwich making for the homeless events to 10 months instead of 6 months and for this ministry to be used for God's glory
- Guidance for new Discipleship International Leaders, I am mentoring to lead one-to-one and new class in ETS in February 2012 at Fujian Evangelical Church
- For our new Accountability group at Trinity Baptist Church
- My own personal commitment to exercise more to prepare myself for Mission trips
